



Animal Care Volunteer – Laundry

Do you like to listen to music while folding linens, and want to really help the Animal Care staff? Well we have the perfect job for you!

As you can imagine, there is a lot of laundry generated by caring for the hundreds of animals in shelter- we need your help washing, drying, and folding our supply of bedding and towels. There are morning and afternoon laundry shifts: the morning shift starts at 10am, the afternoon shift starts at 2pm. Each shift lasts approximately two hours and requires being outdoors in a sheltered area.

Time Commitment

- Minimum of two hours per week

Qualifications

- Comfortable bending, squatting, and kneeling
- May need to lift 10 lbs. or more
- Will require standing/walking for the majority of the shift

Training Required

- On-the-job training

Duties

- Put soiled laundry in washing machines; place washed loads in the dryer; fold and put away clean items
- Keep laundry area and shelves tidy
